Dear Parents,

We are currently preparing for the end of the second quarter and student mid-term examinations. Tri-City Christian Academy will administer the mid-term examinations beginning next Tuesday, January 17th. Students will be given a copy of the exam schedule so that they may plan their preparation. This examination period will conclude on Thursday the 19th, leaving Friday available as a make up opportunity for students to satisfy any outstanding assignments. Should students miss an examination, they should talk to the pertinent teacher before Thursday so that arrangements can be made to make up the exam prior to the end of the week. The cafeteria, incidentally, will also remain open and serve lunch throughout the examination term.

The school's operating hours will remain the same except for the allowance of early dismissal once examinations are completed. Given the gravity of these evaluative examinations students are **strongly** encouraged to return home immediately following the completion of their examinations at 12:30PM provided they have no exams, class work, or quarter tests to complete. If you wish for your child to be dismissed, please fill out the permission slip below excusing him/her from school. Your child should submit this permission slip to his/her homeroom teacher. If your child will be leaving with an individual not otherwise represented on the enrollment form, please indicate this on the permission slip. Students remaining during the afternoon will have a study hall that they **will be required to use** to ensure adequate preparation for impending exams. It is important that students bring the appropriate books, notes, and materials to ensure productivity during these important study hall sessions.

Mid-term examinations cover the information your child has learned during the first and second academic quarters. Therefore, it is imperative that we impress upon the students the importance of adequate preparation for these exams. In the ensuing days, teachers will be using class time to review for these exams. Students should use this time of preparation wisely dedicating sufficient time for coursework study. This will help to ensure optimum performance during this period of serious evaluation.
